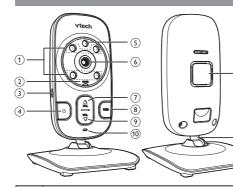

Each newly purchased baby units (VM302) must be paired to your video and audio monitor system (VM312/VM312-2).

ONOTES

- · You can pair a maximum of four baby units to your parent unit. Each new baby unit must be paired to the parent unit before use.
- Make sure you power on the parent unit before pairing.

To pair and replace a baby unit:

- 1. Press **MENU/select** when the parent unit is not in use.
- 2. Press VOL▼ or VOL▲ to choose .
- 3. Press ◀ or ► to choose a desired baby unit slot, then press MENU/SELECT. The screen displays 🕱.

If you choose an occupied baby unit slot, the new baby unit will replace the existing baby unit.

4. Press and hold 0 on the new baby unit until the **POWER** light flashes. Then immediately press and hold PAIR until the POWER light turns on.

When pairing is successful, the screen displays \checkmark , and then the image from the newly paired baby unit.

- If pairing fails, the screen displays. Try the pairing process again
- · Only one baby unit can be paired at a time.

To unpair a baby unit:

Make sure you power on the baby unit and the parent unit before unpairing the baby unit.

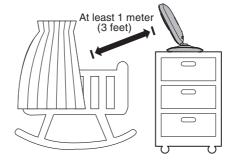
- 1. Press **MENU/SELECT** when the parent unit is not in use.
- Press VOL▼ or VOL▲ to scroll to ■.
- 3. Press ◀ or ► to select the desired baby unit (1, 2, 3 or 4).
- 4. Press and hold TALK until X and V display.
- 5. Press ◀ or ► to select X to cancel, or ✓ to confirm the unpair process.
- 6. Press MENU/SELECT to confirm your selection.

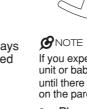

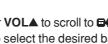

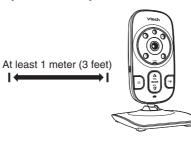
When unpairing is successful, the POWER light on the selected baby unit flashes. The parent unit displays to for a while, and then the image from the baby unit previously viewing.

Positioning the baby monitor

Keep the baby unit out of the reach of the baby. Never place or mount the baby unit inside the baby's crib or

If you experience audio feedback on either the parent unit or baby unit, move the parent unit further away until there is no more audio feedback; or press VOLV on the parent unit to lower the audio feedback sound.

2. Place the parent unit at least 1 meter / 3 feet away from the baby unit.



Operating range

The operating range of the baby monitor is up to 300 meters (1,000 feet) outdoors or 50 meters (160 feet) indoors. The actual operating range may vary depending on the environmental conditions, and other interferences such as walls, doors, and other obstructions.

General product care

To keep this product working well and looking good, follow these guidelines:

- Avoid putting it near heating appliances and devices that generate electrical noise (for example, motors or fluorescent lamps).
- DO NOT expose it to direct sunlight or moisture.
- Avoid dropping the product or treating it roughly.
- Clean with a soft cloth.
- DO NOT immerse the baby unit in water and do not clean them under the tap.
- DO NOT use cleaning spray or liquid cleaners.
- Make sure the baby unit is dry before you connect them to the mains again.

Important safety instructions

When using your equipment, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock and injury, including the following:

- 1. Follow all warnings and instructions marked on the product.
- Adult setup is required.
- 3. This product is intended as an aid. It is not a substitute for responsible and proper adult supervision and should not be used as such.

- 8. Unplug this product from the wall outlet before cleaning. Do not use liquid or aerosol cleaners. Use a damp cloth for cleaning.

- 10. Do not allow anything to rest on the power cords. Do not install this product where the cords may be walked on or crimped.

- 1. Use and store the product at a temperature between 32°F and 104°F.

- 3. Make sure the baby unit(s) and the adapter cord(s) are always out of reach of the baby, at least 3 feet away from the baby or crib. to avoid a possible strangulation hazard.
- 4. Never place the baby unit(s) inside the baby's crib or playpen. Never cover the baby unit(s) with anything such as a towel or a blanket.
- 5. Other electronic products may cause interference with your baby monitor. Try installing your baby monitor as far away from these electronic devices as possible: wireless routers, radios, cellular telephones, intercoms, room monitors, televisions, personal computers, kitchen appliances and cordless telephones.

This limited warranty extends only to the Consumer for Products purchased and used in the United States of America and Canada.

What will VTech do if the Product is not free from defects in materials and workmanship during the limited warranty period ("Materially Defective Product")?

During the limited warranty period, VTech's authorized service representative will repair or replace at VTech's option, without charge, a Materially Defective Product. If we repair the Product. we may use new or refurbished replacement parts. If we choose to replace the Product, we may replace it with a new or refurbished Product of the same or similar design. We will retain defective parts, modules, or equipment. Repair or replacement of the Product, at VTech's option, is your exclusive remedy. VTech will return the repaired or replacement Products to you in working condition. You should expect the repair or replacement to take approximately 30 days.

How long is the limited warranty period?

The limited warranty period for the Product extends for ONE (1) YEAR from the date of purchase. If VTech repairs or replaces a Materially Defective Product

under the terms of this limited warranty, this limited warranty also applies to the repaired or replacement Product for a period of either (a) 90 days from the date the repaired or replacement Product is shipped to you or (b) the time remaining on the original one-year warranty; whichever is longer.

What is not covered by this limited warranty?
