Important safety instructions

When using your equipment, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock and injury, including the following:

- Follow all warnings and instructions marked on the product.
- 2. Adult setup is required.
- 3. This This product is not a substitute for adult supervision of the infant. Supervising the infant is the parent's or caregiver's responsibility. This product could cease operating, and therefore you should not assume it will continue working properly for any given period of time. Further, this is not a medical device and should not be used as such. This product is intended to assist you in supervising your baby.
- Do not use this product near water. For example, do not use it next to a bath tub, wash bowl, kitchen sink, laundry tub or swimming pool, or in a wet basement or shower.
- 5. CAUTION: Use only the batteries indicated in this manual. There may be a risk of explosion if a wrong type of battery is used for the parent unit. Use only the supplied rechargeable battery or replacement battery pack (BT290865) for the parent unit. Do not dispose of batteries in a fire. They may explode. Dispose of used battery according to the information in The RBRC® seal.
- Use only the adapters included with this product. Incorrect adapter polarity or voltage can seriously damage the product.

Parent unit power adapter:

Output: 5V DC 1.5A

Camera unit power adapter:

Output: 5V DC 1500mA.

- The power adapter is intended to be correctly oriented in a vertical or floor mount position. The prongs are not designed to hold the plug in place if it is plugged into a ceiling, under-the-table or cabinet outlet.
- For pluggable equipment, the socket-outlet (power adapter) shall be installed near the equipment and shall be easily accessible.
- Unplug this product from the wall outlet before cleaning. Do not use liquid or aerosol cleaners. Use a damp cloth for cleaning.
- 10. Do not cut off the power adapters to replace them with other plugs, as this causes a hazardous situation
- 11. Do not allow anything to rest on the power cords.

 Do not install this product where the cords may be walked on or crimped.

- 12. This product should be operated only from the type of power source indicated on the marking label. If you are not sure of the type of power supply in your home, consult your dealer or local power company.
- 13. The equipment is to be supplied from an identified USB port complying with the requirements of Limited Power Source.
- Do not overload wall outlets or use an extension cord.
- 15. Do not place this product on an unstable table, shelf, stand or other unstable surfaces.
- 16. This product should not be placed in any area where proper ventilation is not provided. Slots and openings in the back or bottom of this product are provided for ventilation. To protect them from overheating, these openings must not be blocked by placing the product on a soft surface such as a bed, sofa or rug. This product should never be placed near or over a radiator or heat register.
- 17. Never push objects of any kind into this product through the slots because they may touch dangerous voltage points or create a short circuit. Never spill liquid of any kind on the product.
